The Open Meeting of the North County USBC Association held this spring will hold elections for the following officers, directors and delegates. There is a copy of the Nomination Form attached for the use by any association member wishing to submit his/her name for a position on the North County USBC Association Board of Directors or National /State Delegate representing NCUSBC.

Offices which are up for election at the 2010 Annual Meeting are:

First Vice President

Third Vice President (Youth Position)

Five Adult Directors #2, 4, 6, 8, 10

Three Youth Directors #2, 4, 6

Two National Delegates for the USBC Convention in 2011

Six Adult State Delegates/Three Youth State Delegates (2Adult,1Youth) for the California USBC Convention in June of 2011

The following information from the North County USBC Association Bylaws explains the qualifications required to run for the above positions.

Article V. Board of Directors - Management, Section B.

A candidate for the board must be:

- 1. A USBC member in good standing of the association at the time of election and throughout their term.**
- 2. Elected or appointed without regard to race, color, religion, gender, disability, national origin, or age, other than the minimum age of 14 and be reasonably representative of the membership.**
 - a. Any member of the board authorized to sign contracts or acting as a signatory on association accounts must be a minimum age of 18.**
 - b. Six members of the board must be selected from the Youth Committee to be confirmed by the youth representatives at the Annual Open Meeting.**
 - c. A maximum of three bowling center proprietors or their representatives may serve on the board at one time.**

Section C. Election of Directors

Directors whose positions are subject to election by the adult members are elected by a majority vote of adult members, present and voting, from:

- 1. A slate provided by the Nominating Committee.**
- 2. Nominations from the floor. Qualifications must be submitted to the Nominating Committee.**

Voting will be by ballot if there is more than one nominee for each position.

Article VI. Officers, Section B. Election

Officers are elected by a majority vote of the ALL members, present and voting from:

- 1. A slate provided by the Nominating Committee.**

2. **Nominations from the floor. Qualifications must be submitted to the Nominating Committee. Voting will be by ballot if there is more than one nominee for each position.**

Note: If a majority vote is not reached on the first ballot, the candidate receiving the lowest vote total is dropped and balloting continues until a candidate receives a majority vote.

When a candidate is nominated from the floor, the signed, written consent of the candidate along with three (3) copies of the nomination form and resume must be filed with the Chairman, Nominating Committee prior to the nomination. The nominator shall be prepared to read the qualifications for the nominee.

The youth bowler must be fourteen (14) years of age or older as of August 1st of the current season and be a USBC Certified member and remain an eligible Youth member during his/her term, except due to age.

Any youth representative (Youth Representatives are adults representing youth leagues) or youth bowler is eligible to run for a position on the North County USBC Youth Committee. Six members of the Youth Committee are selected by the Youth Committee, presented to and elected by the youth representatives present at the meeting to sit on the North County USBC Board of Directors. This year, three of those will be elected for a two year term. After the Youth Committee members are elected, the entire Youth Committee will meet briefly to select the three members who will be presented to the youth representatives for election to the Board. After they elect their representatives, the newly elected representatives will be introduced to the membership and the Board. All adult youth representatives must wear their RVP (Registered Volunteer Program) badges when working youth or adult/youth events.

Also elected will be two delegates to the 2011 National Convention in ____ and 6 Adult Delegates and 3 Youth Delegates (2Adults, 1Youth) to the 2011 State Convention in Southern California.
