## 2022 CALIFORNIA USBC ASSOCIATION (CUSBC) SENIOR SINGLES TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament is open to current USBC adult members in good standing certified by California Associations. NO CARDS SOLD ON SITE. All entrants must be at least 50 years of age at the time of participation in the tournament (date of birth MUST be on the entry.) NOTE: Failure to report the correct birth date may result in disqualification.
2. Bowlers do NOT need to belong to a senior league to be eligible for entry in this tournament.
3. Bowlers must check in 45 minutes prior to scheduled squad time with VALID IDENTIFICATION and proof of USBC membership (current USBC membership card, bowl.com profile printout or a letter of verification from the local USBC association).
4. Tournament dates: August 19-21, 2022. Closing date: August 21, 2022 at $1: 15 \mathrm{pm}$. Walk-ins allowed, but must sign up no less than one half hour prior to the start of the squad. Walk-ins must provide a bowl.com average printout in order to enter brackets or enter at 220.
5. This is a handicap singles tournament consisting of two separate divisions: Open Division (men and women) \& Women's Division (women only). Within each division are six age classifications: 50-54 / 55-59 / 60-64 / 65-69 / 70-74 / 75+.
6. Format: This tournament will consist of six games bowled on the same pair of lanes. Total pins plus handicap, when applicable, will determine the champions in each division. If there are less than 10 entries per division, the divisions will be consolidated as necessary.
7. The tournament shall be conducted on a handicap basis $-90 \%$ of 220.
8. Entry fee: $\$ 50$ per person (prize fund: $\$ 20$ + lineage: $\$ 18$ + expenses: $\$ 12$ ). Make checks or money orders payable to CUSBC. Write "Sr. Singles" in memo. Credit card payments are accepted via Paypal online at CALUSBC.com. Any returned payments must be paid in cash or money order on-site plus a $\$ 50$ penalty fee.
9. Re-entries are based on squad availability. Bowlers can enter multiple times, but only the highest score will be used for cashing.
10. The entering average shall be determined by the following priorities:
a. Highest 2019-20 AND 2020-21 Winter/Summer certified average (min. of 21 games). If none,
b. Highest USBC certified CURRENT league average ( min .21 games) as of tournament date. If none,
c. Highest 2018-19 USBC (Winter/Summer) certified average (min. of 21 games). If none,
d. Assigned average: Women 165; Men 185.

Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own averages. If a "sport" or "modified" league average is the bowler's only verifiable average, it will be adjusted per the USBC sport chart to determine the correct entering average. Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify scores if submitted average is lower than correct average thereby resulting in more handicap. Prize winning will be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average.
11. If a bowler's current 21 game average as of August 12, 2022 is 10 or more pins higher than the previous season's average, that average must be used (USBC Rule 319a-2). Failure to comply will be cause for disqualification and loss of entry fee.
12. Bowlers shall adjust their entering averages and shall submit the adjusted average to the tournament manager if during the 12-month period immediately preceding the date and time of bowling, the bowler's composite average for all, but not less than 21 tournament games, exceeds such entering average by 15 or more pins (USBC Rule 319e).
13. All entrants must report any re-rate or adjustments to averages from any other tournament or event prior to participation. A bowler's average may be adjusted upward before participation in any event. If the assigned average is not accepted by the bowler, the entry fee shall be refunded (Rule 319c). Failure to comply will be cause for disqualification and loss of entry fee. Nothing in USBC Rule 319 e will be deemed to supersede the authority of tournament management to adjust a bowler's average upward prior to bowling. For purposes of average adjustment, tournament management will use guidelines including, but not limited to, USBC averages, previous tournament winnings and any records of bowler performance from league(s) and/or tournament(s).
14. All entrants who have qualified for $\$ 300$ or more in any tournament event or division of an event during the 12 months prior to participation, must attach a report with the entry form showing actual score bowled and the amount of money won in each case (USBC Rule 319d). Failure to comply may be cause for disqualification and loss of entry fee.
15. Replacements for original entrants may be made providing the replacement meets eligibility and average requirements per Rule 10. A replacement must bowl under their own name at the time the event is scheduled.
16. All prize money will be returned $100 \%$. Prize ratio is at least $1: 6$ per division. In the event of first place ties, co-champions will be declared and prize money will be combined and divided equally. Designated prize funds will be paid accordingly to each division within 30 days upon completion of the tournament, except when USBC nationals has authorized delay in payment, pending settlement of any claim or protest which effects position standings. A symbolic award will be furnished for the champion in each age class.
17. Winners in each age classification are eligible to participate in the 2023 USBC Senior National Championships. Participation fees will be paid by CUSBC. Since only one bowler is eligible to participate in the National Seniors Tournament per division, all ties must be broken. Ties will be broken by using the highest 3 game series with handicap (i.e., first 3 game set, then second 3 game set). If a tie still exists, ties will be broken by using highest game with handicap starting with game 1. Arrangements will be made with each athlete within stated guidelines and parameters from the CUSBC for attending the National Finals. Eligible advancers must agree to bowl in the National Finals or, failing to do so, agree to waive all rights. In the event a winner is unable or declines to attend the national tournament, alternates will be used based on their order of finish per division.
18. Bowlers arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Missed frames shall be credited with a zero. Frames may not be made-up. Bowlers not present to bowl when it's their turn will be credited with a zero for that frame. In the event a bowler cannot finish their series, zero points will be scored the remaining frames.
19. Any PBA or PWBA member, past or present that does not meet the average requirements of rule \#10, must enter at 220.
20. This tournament is certified by USBC. Any violation of tournament rules is cause for disqualification, loss of entry fee, forfeit of all prize monies and possible suspension from USBC membership.
21. An appeal or protest involving eligibility or playing rules must be filed in writing with the tournament director within 72 hours of the time of bowling and before tournament prizes are paid. The tournament director shall be the authority to interpret USBC and tournament rules, policies and procedures in deciding disputes. If deemed necessary, the tournament director shall consult with the board of directors of the CUSBC. The decision of USBC is final and binding on all involved parties.
